Copies of all required documentation must be provided at least two weeks before the event (i.e. by Monday 5 April) and please bring them with you on the day for checking. * All vehicles constructed or first registered more than 40 years ago and meeting the requirements of being a Vehicle of Historic Interest are exempt from MOT testing. Documentary evidence of the roadworthiness of such vehicles is still required with your entry - this may be in the form of a valid voluntary MOT or a record of a roadworthiness inspection by a person competent to undertake such inspection in accordance with the relevant VOSA Inspection Manual.
